THE Union Government with an objective of improving the medical services and infrastructure of health centres started 'Kayakalp' scheme under which Tirora's Sub-District Hospital has been declared first prize at the Statelevel for the year 2015–16. Also, the Primary Health Center of Chopa village under Goregaon tehsil has been declared first prize at district-level. Both the health centres would get Rs 15 lakh and Rs 2 lakh as reward under the scheme.

The health centres of Thane in Amgaon, Mahagoan in Arjuni Morgaon, Mulla in Deori and Bhanpur in Gondia tehsil were also awarded with consolation prize of Rs 50,000 each.

The Sub District Hospital in Tirora is the only big hospital in tehsil and large number of patients especially from the rural areas visit daily for medical treatment, hence the services here are free of cost. The then Gondia Collector Dr Vijay Suryawanshi had requested Adanis to support for transformation of the hospital under Kayakalp yojana.

Following this, under the guidance of Station Head Chaitanya Sahoo, Adani Foundation and APML team with supporting staff took pains for transforming the hospital. It has taken almost one year for this transformation and the sincere efforts has brought laurel for the hospital.
